Eisenhower Elementary Library	Library Stem Grant	This project provides materials for students to participate in STEM and building projects related to literacy and stories in the library. The grant provides Keva planks and related materials which can be used year after year in many challenges and building projects.
MacArthur Elementary School	And So They Soar	In Spring 2022, students in grades 4K-5th enrolled at MacArthur Elementary will participate in "And So They Soar," a program designed for students to show their cultural heritage and tell their life journey through storytelling.
Tank Elementary School	2nd Grade Tank Elementary Field Trips	Funding for this grant provides grade level field trips that match curriculum standards to enhance the learning experience for a second-grade classroom.
Washington Middle School	Drumming on a Drum	Funding for this grant allows Washington Middle School's music program to purchase sound suppression cymbals and remo tubano drums.
Martin Elementary School	Kimochis Social Emotional Learning Program	Funding from this grant will be used to purchase the Kimochis® Educator Tool Kit for elementary- aged students. Kimochis® is a social-emotional learning curriculum used to enhance student connections, self-esteem, and relationship building skills.
NEW School of Innovation	Culturally Responsive Resources	This grant provides culturally responsive instruction and resources to enhance the reading and writing learning opportunity for the Academy program students.
East Green Bay High School	Culturally Responsive Classroom Library	Funding for this grant will purchase culturally responsive books for a classroom library that are appropriate for all reader levels.
Green Bay East High School	Green Bay East High School GSA Club	This grant provides the Gay Straight Alliance (GSA) club funds to purchase supplies that promote the existence of the club, celebrate the 20th anniversary, and educate the school community on issues that affect LGBTQIA+ youth.
Franklin Middle School	IB a Leader Social Emotional Learning Period	Funding for this grant will purchase supplies for teachers to use during their Social Emotional Learning lessons which celebrate achievements, build community, practice reflecting, and develop community.
Kennedy Elementary School	Autism Program	This grant provides funds for students with autism to visit Exceptional Equestrians, a community based equine center, and engage in "off horse" experiences to improve emotional regulation and social skills.
Howe Elementary Community School	Flexible Seating	This grant provides funding for alternative and flexible seating options to help build distinct areas in classrooms.
