Encompass Early Education and Care	Building for Resilience: Oconto Falls Childcare & Family Support	The forthcoming Encompass Center in Oconto Falls will address a lack of high-quality affordable childcare and a lack of workforce due to the need for childcare. This grant supports the renovation of an existing building that includes an Advocate Nook, a space for one-on-one support for children and families that helps to prepare children for success and build self-sufficiency in families.
Golden House	Domestic Violence Homicide Prevention & Response	Funds provide support to a dedicated position that will focus on domestic violence homicide prevention and response across Northeastern Wisconsin, as a response to the increased number of fatalities related to domestic abuse. The position will implement new initiatives and create programming to support victims, their families and friends in the wake of a homicide.
Kewaunee County Department of Human Services	Kewaunee County Wraparound	Kewaunee County Human Services is creating a safe and affordable housing option so families can focus on identified areas of need. Many of the families served by the agency are struggling with deep-rooted poverty and until their basic needs are met, they will struggle to focus on treatment needs. The agency will wrap around the individuals residing in the home to fully support human services related needs.
The Gateway Collective	Socially Inclusive Housing	Housing instability is one of the biggest factors for homelessness. The Gateway Collective exists to develop affordable and holistic socially inclusive housing. Grant funding will support the City Center Lofts project in downtown Green Bay.
Veterans 1st of New	Veterans 1st of NEW Capital Campaign	Veterans 1st of Northeast Wisconsin is a non-profit addressing the immediate needs of our men and women who have served our country and need supportive housing. Funding will be used towards the purchase of discounted materials to build 13 tiny homes and a community center for programming.
We All Rise: African American Resource Center	All Seasons Transformation	Funding will support All Seasons Transformation, a 49-bed transitional living facility for men who are experiencing a transition in their lives. This secure and sober facility serves men through advocacy, safety, and support. Our residential facility is centered on guest autonomy, clinical and community intervention strategies, health, and wellbeing, fostering a pathway that allows our participants time and support as they build up their strength and skillsets on their road to regaining their independence.
