Franciscan Peacemakers	Clare Community, Outreach, Hospitality Center	Grant funding will support women who have been sexually exploited through prostitution, or human sex trafficking, and dually affected by substance abuse. The trauma of being sexually assaulted, traded, sold and abused cuts deeply into a woman's spiritual, emotional, mental and physical being. Funding will help us to guide them on a path to better health and healing.
Hope Clinic and Care Center	Primary Care and Care Management	Funding will bolster the Primary Care and Care Management services, designed to offer accessible healthcare to those in need, while emphasizing the critical aspects of addressing both physical health and socioeconomic factors that profoundly impact well-being in our community.
Rock River Community Clinic	Increasing Pediatric Access to Comprehensive Healthcare in Jefferson, Dodge, and Walworth County	This grant will increase pediatric access to medical, dental, and behavioral health services for low income families with children in Jefferson, Dodge, and Walworth Counties.
